A newcomers program to help international students transition to a U.S. school.



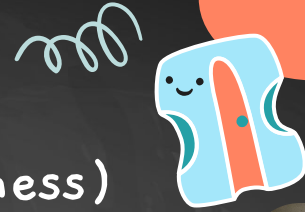
